Processing: Destemmed and Crushed to T-Bin Fermenters (3/4 ton).

Fermentation: 27 Days in Fermenter.

Pre-Fermentation Additions: SO₂ (70ppm), ColorPro (80ppm), 1.3% Water, 0.2 g/Lt Tartaric Acid, Assmanshausen Yeast, ML Prime Bacteria, Fermaid-K.

Barrel Aging: Pressed to 4-5 Year Old French Oak Barrels.
